Are you a dependent student from Maine enrolled full-time at a Maine community college?

Is one of your parents out of work?

Then keep reading...

The Graduation Protection Assurance Program (G.P.A.) has been created to help make sure that young adults who are attending a Maine community college full-time don't have to leave school for financial reasons if one of their parents is unemployed or loses a job.

The program is designed to cover the cost of tuition and fees (not room and board) and will be in effect from fall 2009 through spring 2011.

If you are a dependent student from Maine and one (or both) of your parents has just lost a job or has been out of work for a while as a result of the current economic downturn, you may qualify.

If you think you might be eligible, contact the financial aid office at your college.
