Successful completion of high school, adult education biology lab, or a college biology with a "C" grade or better. (BIO 213 preferred choice at college level).	Within Past 5 Years	
Successful completion of high school Algebra I & II or equivalent within past 5 years or KVCC MAT031– Intro. To Algebra class or Adult Education equivalent class or ACCUPLACER score to place into MAT 117 College Algebra.	Within past 5 years. Minimum grade of "C" for class options. Accuplacer score 75 or higher	
Successful completion of high school or college physics is recommended.	Recommendation	
Take the HOBET entrance exam	HOBET exam may be taken twice a year no less than 45 days apart	
Math score	57 or higher	
Reading score	54 or higher
