- For some technical courses, a combination of education and experience will be considered as appropriate credentials.

- Current State of Maine radiologic technology license or eligibility
- Current ARRT registration
- Current ARRT – certification in the area of instruction
- Experience in the area will be taken into consideration in lieu of degree
