POSITION TITLE: Full-time Social Science (Mental Health) Instructor
(Position starts Fall 2012)

QUALIFICATIONS: A minimum of a Master's degree in Counseling (Rehabilitation), Social Work, or Psychology with experience in community based mental health services. Teaching experience preferred.
