



## **DIAGNOSTIC MEDICAL SONOGRAPHER PROGRAM**

### **Admission Pre-requisites**

1. Allied Health Associate Degree\* (two year) that is patient care related including but not limited to: Radiologic Technologist, Associate Degree Nursing, Respiratory Therapist, Physical Therapist Assistant, Medical Laboratory Technologist, or Bachelor's Degree \* ( Either credential with a GPA of 2.5 or better . Student must have college English, Anatomy and Physiology, College Level Physics, and College Algebra or higher).
2. Documentation of patient care experience or CNA course.
3. Proof of immunization against tetanus, measles, mumps, rubella, Varicella (titre), Hepatitis B (series and titre), and a negative test for tuberculosis (2- step PPD).
4. Students born after 1957 must have immunity from rubella and rubeola. A history of Varicella (chicken pox) is required, either by verbal report, vaccination or proof of immunity.

### **Specific Admission Requirements**

Applicants must have completed a two year equivalent accredited allied health training program that is patient care related, e.g., radiologic technology, nursing, physical therapy, etc.

1. In lieu of #1, a Bachelor's Degree in Science qualifies for admission.
2. The following college level courses are required with grades of "C" or higher:
  - Algebra, statistics or higher level mathematics course;
  - Human Anatomy and Physiology I and II, with laboratories;
  - Communication Skills (may be met by a variety of courses including, English, speech or composition;
  - General college-level physics and/or radiographic physics.
3. Medical Terminology is strongly recommended.
