Transfer Agreement

This Agreement provides transfer admission opportunities for academically qualified students and graduates of Kennebec Valley Community College (KVCC), who are interested in completing their Bachelor's degree through Saint Joseph's College Online (SJC).


Terms of Agreement:

- I. The Saint Joseph's College Online program most suitable for articulation with KVCC is the following: Associate of Applied Science in Health Information Technology to Bachelor of Science in Health Information Management (BSHIM). The accompanying degree plan table reflects the degree requirements for this program, which may be subject to change.
- II. Saint Joseph's College Online will accept for admission a degree candidate who has earned a grade point average of 2.0 or better (based on a 4.0 scale) into the online BSHIM program, upon confirmation of official transcripts. The student must be in good standing with KVCC and meet any specific admission and enrollment standards and requirements for the program at SJC.
- III. KVCC students accepted at SJC will receive academic credit for all College level courses that were successfully completed with a letter grade of C or better and are deemed comparable (based on current course description information, course/degree requirements and agreement by the representatives of the respective programs) to current SJC courses. Non-credit or remedial courses will not be accepted for transfer credit and/or graduation requirements. All transcripts will be reviewed on an individual basis.

- IV. KVCC students/graduates need to submit an application and official transcripts from KVCC, as well as any other educational institutions previously attended.
- V. If a student does not have the foundation or skill to enroll in an upper level course due to a lack of the appropriate introductory course(s), any necessary prerequisite course(s) will be required.
- VI. Prerequisite and/or general education courses required for the BSHIM may be transferred from KVCC or other accredited institutions, but 25% of the identified course requirements must be completed at SJC.
- VII. SJC agrees to waive the application fee for all students of KVCC.
- VIII. This agreement will be reviewed annually and may be revised by mutual consent. In addition, SJC and KVCC agree to notify one another in writing, at least one semester in advance of program changes that might affect the transfer of students under this agreement.
- IX. Both entities agree to the right to use each other's names in print and media advertising to the public for the purpose of marketing the programs described herein.
- X. KVCC agrees to promote this partnership and provide informational materials to their students and graduates. SJC will reciprocate by including the partnership on its webpage.







Guidelines for transfer credit applicability

Sciences

Includes all science courses except behavioral and social sciences.

Examples: Anatomy and Physiology, Microbiology, Biological Sciences (Botany, Zoology, Animal Behavior), Environmental/Ecology, Entomology, Chemistry, Physical Sciences (Geology, Physics, Earth Science, Astronomy, Geography)

Social Sciences

Broadly defined as human and behavioral sciences

Examples: Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Social Work (including Human Services and Social Welfare courses), Political Science (including American Government)

Philosophy

May include Philosophy, Logic and Ethics. Must be coded as Philosophy.

Examples: Philosophy, Logic & Ethics

Not Acceptable: Medical Ethics

Ethics

Must be general ethics/philosophy based

Examples: Ethics

Not Acceptable: Medical Ethics

Theology

Bible Studies, Theology, Religious Studies. Must fall under the department of Religion or Theology

Examples: World Religions, Theology of Christ

History

Includes all college level history courses cataloged within the history department.

Examples: World Civilization, U.S. History, Western Civilization

Not Acceptable: Courses that are based within a specific major such as Educational History.

Humanities

Examples: Theater/Drama/Film (History or Appreciation), Music (History or Appreciation), Art (History or Appreciation), Literature, Mythology, Foreign Language, History, Philosophy, Theology, Humanities survey courses

Not Acceptable: Education courses, Applied art (Ceramics, drawing, sculpture, photography, silkscreen, watercolor), Applied music courses (chorus, piano, French horn, etc.), Speech or Public Speaking or Broadcasting journalism courses, Writing courses (grammar, business writing, tech. writing, creative writing, etc.), Political Science, ASL American Sign Language

General Elective

Any of a variety of college level courses. May include courses in applied arts and sign language, business courses, accounting courses, social sciences, nursing etc.

Examples: Business Ethics, Medical Bioethics, Nursing 101, Intro to Paralegal

Not Acceptable: Physical education courses, vocational courses or other course work that does not have a theoretical basis.

Saint Joseph's College Online will grant transfer credit from accredited colleges or universities with a course grade of "C" or better, provided the course is applicable. To earn a degree through Saint Joseph's College Online students must complete 25% of courses at Saint Joseph's College. Students may transfer up to 95 credits to a Bachelor's degree at Saint Joseph's College Online. Students must take a minimum of 33 credits with Saint Joseph's College Online, 18 of those credits must be within your major/specialization.
