The Maine Forensic Phlebotomy Program is a State of Maine, Bureau of Highway Safety approved training designed to assist qualified law enforcement officers in the procedures of venipuncture for investigative purposes. Law enforcement officers will learn the ethical and legal aspects of phlebotomy, anatomy and physiology and safety precautions. Satisfactory completion of 80 successful blood draws will be required in a clinical setting. Potential Clinical sites available include sites in Augusta, Bangor and Waterville.

In order for officers to receive their certificate of completion they must complete their clinical rotation within 60 days of the lab end date.

To qualify for Acceptance into the Forensic Phlebotomy Program Officers must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be a certified law enforcement or corrections officer who is off probation with his/her agency.*
- 2. Applicants must provide a letter of support from agency to attend the course and can attest to the applicant's credibility (on agency letterhead signed by agency head).*
- 3. Complete the Registration Form.*
