Academic Readiness	Applicants must demonstrate, through multiple measures, the ability to be successful in college-level math and writing. Multiple measures may include, high school coursework, college coursework, testing assessments such as the Accuplacer, SAT, GED and HiSET scores, military training, life experience, as well as personal interviews.	
Minimum GPA	Applicants must be in good academic standing with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher in high school, at KVCC, or at any other college or university attended.	
Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Class A - Permit* or License	To be admitted to the program, applicants MUST provide a copy of a valid Class A Driver's License or a valid Class A Permit*. *Permit holders must provide proof (before August 1st of the year they enter the LWP program) that they have earned or are actively enrolled in a training course to complete their Class A License. Driving Record	During the first week of the Fall semester, students undergo a background check to ascertain if they have a clean driving record.	
Program Orientation Upon successful completion of the above entrance requirements, you will receive an acceptance letter. Important information about required tools and equipment will be covered at this event, as well as program expectations. Plan to attend.
